Week 1: Bonfire night Little Glow

LIT: Children will create a fireworkbased picture and write the sounds fireworks make.

Maths: Children will work on the shapes circles and triangles.

EAD: Children will paint use different techniques to create a firework picture. UTW: (History) Children will discuss what they will be doing for bonfire night and the reasons as to why we celebrate it. Fire Safety

Week 2: Remembrance Where the poppies grow

LIT: Children will write key words about the animals in the story.

Maths: Children will build up their understanding of the number of 4 including subitising

EAD: Children will create a Poppy collage using tissue paper and using ICT UTW: (History) Children will talk about the people who went to war and why it was important. Children will also look at the animals that helped in the war.

Week 3: Anti-bullying week Elmer and the big bird

LIT: Children will draw and label a special friend and describe why they are special. Maths: Children will build up their understanding of numbers to 5 including songs relating to 5.

EAD: Children will create a unique Kindness hands creation, draw, cut and personalise - Anti-bullying.

UTW: (Science) Children will look at the changing states of matter as they create kindness cakes.

Week 7:

Shmelf the Hanukkah Elf LIT: Children will describe the journey the elf goes on, story mapping and labelling.

Maths: Children will work on their understanding of spatial awareness using positional language.

EAD: Children will use their fine motor control skills to make a Menorah with the correct number of candles.

UTW: (RE) Children will look into what Hanukkah is and who celebrates it. The children will look at the similarities and differences against Christianity.

Week 4:

If I were in charge of Christmas LIT: Writing invitations, shopping lists for a Christmas party.

Maths: Children will work on one more and one less within 5.

EAD: Using different materials, children will create their own stocking for the fireplace.

UTW: (Science) Children will go on a winter walk and explore the natural world around them. Children will describe what they see, hear and feel while outside.

Week 6: Christmas Around the world
Story about Christmas around the world

LIT: Children will label what tradition happens in different countries.

Maths: Children will work on ordering key events in their daily routines including day and night. They will use language related to time.

EAD: Children will take part in Christmas traditions from around the world including dance, music and food.

UTW: (Geography) Children will understand that there are many countries out there. They will begin to know that each country celebrates Christmas differently. Children will grow their knowledge of the globe.

Week 5: Our Christmas Dear Santa

LIT: Children will write a letter to Santa which will then be posted in the local post box.

Maths: Children will work on recognising shapes with four sides and the differences between them. They will be able to sort items by shape using the correct language to support them.

EAD: Children will work with mixing paint to create their Christmas cards. Different shades of green - trees/wreath UTW: (RE) Children will look at the Christian Christmas story and discuss why it is an important time of year for them. Create a manger scene.
