Science

Properties and changes of materials

This topic will build on our prior knowledge of materials, carrying out investigations into the many properties of materials, applying our scientific knowledge.

Forces

We will learn about gravity, the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction and that some mechanisms including levers, pulleys and gears allow a smaller force to have a greater effect.
